

*Is. 11:11 ¶ Then it will happen on that day that the Lord Will again recover the second time with His hand The remnant of His people, who will remain, From Assyria, Egypt, Pathros, Cush, Elam, Shinar, Hamath, And from the islands of the sea.*

Isaiah deals with the people who will enter the Millennium in Isaiah 11:11 through 12:6.

The worldwide regathering of the Jews in belief (in faith) is discussed here. Notice it will be a *second* regathering, the first being a worldwide regathering in unbelief (which began in 1948 and continues today). The regathering in unbelief is discussed in passages such as Ezekiel 20:33-38, Ezekiel 22:17-22, and Zephaniah 2:1-2, and occurs for the purpose of bringing the Jews to repentance during the Tribulation. The worldwide regathering in belief will be for the purpose of entering the Millennium, a regathering that will be assisted by the Gentile nations (as was discussed in verse 10). The regathering of the Jews from Babylon in 536 BC was not a worldwide regathering. Therefore, it cannot be viewed as the first worldwide regathering in unbelief.

If there is to be a *second* regathering of the Jews (the *second* regathering being in a state of belief), then we must understand how the Jews are driven out of the land of Canaan after the first regathering (the first regathering being in a state of unbelief). When a large portion of the Jews sign a *covenant* with the Antichrist (Daniel 9:27), the Tribulation will begin. However, in the *middle* of the seven years of Tribulation (three and one half years after the Tribulation begins), the Antichrist will break the *covenant* and seek to destroy all the Jews (Daniel 9:27; Revelation 12:1-6, 13-17). When this occurs, the Jews will *flee to the mountains* (Matthew 24:15-22) in *the wilderness* (Revelation 12:6, 14). It is interesting that *Bozrah*, located in modern day southern Jordan, is a mountainous wilderness and the location of the Second Coming, based on Isaiah 34:1-8, Isaiah 63:1-6, Micah 2:12 (the phrase, "*in the fold*," is interpreted, "*Bozrah*" in the King James Bible), and Habakkuk 3:3 (*Teman* and *Mount Paran* are both in the vicinity of Bozrah). After Jesus returns to save the remnant of the Jews at Bozrah, and defeats the Antichrist and his armies, all Jews from throughout the world will be regathered to the holy land to enjoy the blessings of the Messianic Kingdom. All the Jews on the earth at that time will be believers in Jesus, thus fulfilling Romans 11:26, which states that *all Israel will be saved*. This allows the *new covenant* of Jeremiah 31:31-34 to be fulfilled to the max.
