FAQs...

Can we visit in person to see the facilities before scheduling our event?

Absolutely! We would love for you to come for a visit. It is always beneficial to see everything while planning your event. Please call us at 270-437-4172 to set up a tour of the ministry facilities.

What technology equipment does The Hill provide for events?

The Hill has two large screen TVs on the west wall of the Library Meeting Room for presentations as well as a smaller TV for a speaker monitor on the back wall. Those can be connected via HDMI from your device or via Apple TV wirelessly with compatible devices.

We also provide access to a ceiling mounted projector and screen that is accessed via VGA cable on the south wall of the Library Meeting Room.

The Hill **does not** provide any sound or computer equipment for your event.

How does The Hill function without asking for donations?

When the Lord prompted Bob Warren to found BASIC Training he saw in Scripture that the Lord always supplies the resources for anything He wants done. Also fresh on his mind was a statement by Hudson Taylor, founder of China Inland Missions, "God's plan done God's way never lacks His provision."

All of this led to the firm decision that the ministry would never borrow nor ask for money to accomplish what the Lord wanted done here. Consequently, if the Lord doesn't provide, it doesn't get done. We trust the Lord to support what He wants done here.

Most of our funding comes from donors who respond out of faithfulness to the Holy Spirit's direction and a heart that reflects the generosity of our heavenly Father. Another significant portion of our funding comes from other ministries who rent our facilities for their own events. The sale of Bible studies, books, audio teachings, and other resources also generates a small amount of ministry income.

How many chairs and tables are available for our event at The Hill?

We have 12-6' tables, 24-8' tables, 11-5' round tables, 100-padded conference chairs, 160+-metal folding chairs in the Manna House, 60-metal folding chairs in the meeting room below the Ark available for your event.

What items do I need to bring when I stay at The Hill?

Groups staying the dorm-style housing at The Hill will need to bring the following items:

- Pillow
- Twin-sized linens and blanket or sleeping bag
- Towels and washcloths
- Toiletries: soap, toothpaste, etc.

What is the parking situation at The Hill for handicapped individuals?

There is designated handicap parking in the lot behind the Manna House. There is ramp access from that area. There is also ground floor access to the front (no steps), but parking is further away. Access to the Lodge is also ground level without any steps.

All non-handicapped parking during events, except temporarily loading and unloading, must be done along the entrance road before reaching the "No parking beyond this point" sign. Attendee vehicles must not block resident access to the circle drive at the cabin.

Can we use facilities at The Hill for shorter events where no one stays overnight?

Yes, under certain circumstances. Usage cannot conflict with another group renting facilities for a week or weekend. Many times the Lodge is available even though a group may be renting the other facilities. As well, a group staying in other areas may not need the Tobacco Barn Picnic Area and Jackson Lake. We would like to rent the facilities for a wedding. Is that possible?

We could literally stay busy full time with weddings at The Hill. However, that does not align with our vision and mission for our facilities to be used in equipping members of the church through biblical teaching and discipleship.

Our board has decided that the only weddings permitted at The Hill are for those who have previously lived here for discipleship.
